This is moving me to take more care in setting the tone at the beginning of the classes – to take more time in allowing people to settle and go inward, with reminders to be open and open-minded, to let go of negative thoughts, allow the feeling of kindness and love to expand from the heart, to draw the attention downward to **BE GROUNDED** and centered in who we are, and bring focus to the here-and- now.

Our T'ai Chi Chih practice is like a refuge. We create a unique environment where we feel safe and can let go of our psychological armor. It is a tool of transformation. We can let go of fears, and feelings of uncertainty, angst, or sadness, and feel waves of peace roll through us. We feel the beauty in ourselves and acknowledge it in others. Compassion, insight, and openminded awareness awakens in us. The more we regularly practice, we find the clarity gained during practice becomes a constant, supporting us as we journey this life. We become more cognizant of the connection of human kind and the value of expressing kindness, love, acceptance, and tolerance.

Jack Kornfield, a well-known Vipassana meditation teacher expresses it beautifully:

Now more than ever we need kindness, we need one another, we need the strength of wisdom and wise action.

May we all be present with the fact that this is our world. Plant seeds of goodness and water them everywhere. Then blessings will grow for yourself and for all.

I'd like to encourage all to remember the vastness of time and let ourselves become a manifestation of integrity, with our thoughts, words and deeds. No matter how the outer world turns, compassion in speech and action, virtue and non-harming always brings benefit.
